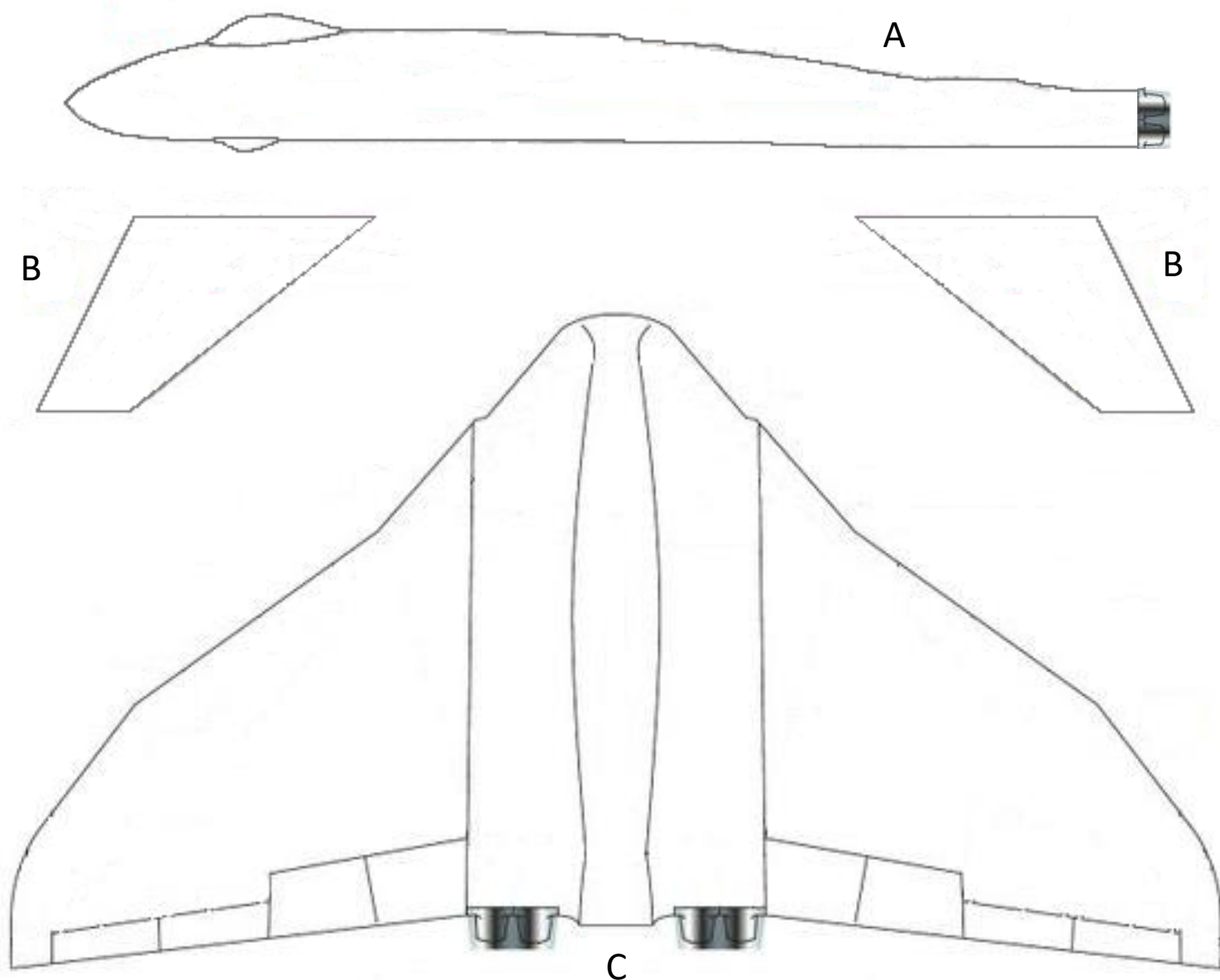


Modelling Paste Aeroplane Template



Directions

1. Trace the outline of the wings (C) and tail fins (B) onto of a blank stencil sheet, using a stencil burner or craft knife, follow the lines cutting out to make stencil. (alternatively you can cut out of card)
2. Roll out modelling paste to approx. 2-4mm in thickness, place stencil over and roll with rolling pin, using a sharp surgical knife cut out shapes.
3. Remove excess paste, smooth sharp edges by gently rubbing with finger, mark lines on wings and tail fins for the flaps, allow to dry while making the body of the plane.
4. For the body of the plane take modelling paste and roll into a long cone shape following the picture (A) as a guide to length and thickness
5. To make the thrusters take some modelling paste roll into cone shapes again and use wings (C) as a guide for length and thickness
6. Assemble plane as shown in the picture video guide on website or YouTube
